The Spanish Honors minor consists of a minimum of 15 credit hours in the study of Iberian, LatinX, Latin American Literatures, Cultures, and Hispanic Linguistics. Students choosing to minor in Spanish are encouraged to take advantage of study abroad opportunities offered in cooperation with The Office of International Affairs (OIA). After a Faculty Advisor in the Department of Spanish and Portuguese has approved the Honors minor, you should file the form with your college or school counselor.

Language Prerequisites (0-4 courses, 0-15 CH)

To complete the required minor coursework at the 3000 level and above (see required courses below), students must first demonstrate intermediate proficiency through Spanish 2202 or 2213. This proficiency can be demonstrated by:

- The Seal of Biliteracy
- Placement testing
- Credit by examination (AP/IB etc.)
- Course enrollment/completion
- A combination of testing and coursework

The beginning/intermediate course sequences for Spanish are as follows:

Spanish 1101 > 1102 > 1103 or 1113 > 2202 or 2213

-OR-

Spanish 1155 > 1103 or 1113 > 2202 or 2213

Required courses (3 courses, 9 CH)

Spanish 3401

Spanish 3403 or 3413

Spanish 3450H

Elective courses (2 courses, 6 CH)

Students choose two 4000 or 5000-level courses, one of which must carry Honors (H) or Embedded Honors (E) status:

Spanish 4430(H), 4532, 4534(E), 4536, 4537, 4538, 4542, 4551(E), 4552(H), 4555(E), 4556, 4557.1, 4557.2, 4558, 4560(H), 4561(H), 4564, 4565H, 4567(H), 4568, 4570, 4580, 4581, 4595(.01, .02, .03), 4606, 4610, 4689S, 5191, 5201, 5202, 5203, 5389, 5620, 5689S

With approval of the Department, the following courses may also count toward Minor requirements:

Spanish 4193, 4194, 4998(H), 4999(H), 5797

Spanish Honors minor program guidelines

The following guidelines govern this minor:

Credit hours required A minimum of 15 credit hours. 1000-level courses shall not count in the minor. At least 6 credit hrs must be upper-level courses as defined by the College of Arts and Sciences.

Transfer and EM credit hours allowed A student is permitted to count up to 6 total hours of transfer credit and/or credit by examination.

Overlap with the GE A student is permitted to overlap up to 6 credit hours between the GE and the minor.

Overlap with the major and additional minor(s)

- The minor must be in a different subject than the major.
- The minor must contain a minimum of 12 hours distinct from the major and/or additional minor(s).

Grades required

- Minimum C- for a course to be counted on the minor.
- Minimum 2.00 cumulative GPA for all minor course work.
- Course work graded Pass/Non-Pass cannot count on the minor.
- No more than 3 credit hours of course work graded Satisfactory/Unsatisfactory may count toward the minor.

X193 credits No more than 3 credit hours.

Minor approval The minor course work must be approved by the academic unit offering the minor.

Filing the minor program form The minor program form must be filed at the time the graduation application is submitted to a college/school advisor if the student's degree audit report is not showing complete (green).

Changing the minor Once the minor program is filed in the college office, any changes must be approved by the Spanish Minor Advisor.
